

## Information clause on the processing of personal data

Consent to the processing of personal data (Hereinafter the „Consent “)

1. We, the company , My Funding Account P.S.A a Provider incorporated under the laws of Poland Al. Wojciecha Korfantego 138A, 40-156 Katowice, Polska KRS: 0001023771 NIP: 6343021306 REGON: 524681980 on 8th March 2023, with registered office address at Al. Wojciecha Korfantego 138 A, 40 – 156 Katowice reg. no. 0001023771 (hereinafter the „Company“), pursuant to Art. 13 and following of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter the „**GDPR**“) hereby inform you about the means and principles concerning the protection of your privacy and the processing of your Personal data for the purposes specified herein.

2. By opt-in registration box you hereby grant to us your freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous consent to process your Personal data for the purposes specified herein pursuant to the Art. 6 par. 1 let. a) and Art. 7 of the GDPR.

3. The Company, as the controller of the Personal data (hereinafter the “**Controller**”), processes the personal data under the conditions and within the limits set by all applicable legislation and for following purposes: the advertise, market, promote, demonstrate the investment services and activities including ancillary services of investment firms - natural or legal persons who perform investment services and activities using financial instruments, as a regular occupation or business, and on a professional basis including sharing Personal data with such investment firms (hereinafter the “**Purpose**”)

4. The Controller processes for the abovementioned purposes following categories of personal data (hereinafter the “**Personal data**”): name and surname, email, phone number, country of residence.

5. Your Personal data shall be processed for the duration of **5 years** from the grant of the consent (hereinafter the “**Term of processing**”). After the Term of processing has ended you shall be informed about the possibility of granting a new consent regarding further processing of your Personal data. Should you not be informed about this possibility, or shouldn't the new consent be granted, the Controller shall see to the proper deletion of your Personal data.

6. The Controller hereby informs you about his contact details:

You may contact also any processor/recipient and you are entitled to exercise the rights defined below in art. 8 of the Consent.

7. The Controller hereby, pursuant to Art. 13 par. 1 let. e) of the GDPR, informs you that the Personal data shall be provided to the following processors and/or recipients: other providers and Outsourcing companies providing regulated and/or unregulated services to Provider (hereinafter the **“Processors”** or **“Recipient”**). In order to fulfil the Purpose, the Controller does not intend to transfer the Personal data outside of the EHP. The Controller guarantee, that all the Processor/Recipient’s personal data policy are compliant to GDPR and specifically to Consent.

8. You hereby acknowledge that as the data subject, you have following rights as follows from the provisions of the GDPR towards Controller and all the Processors/Recipients:

- the right to withdraw the consent granted at any time either in full or in relation to a specific purpose of processing (shall be done via clicking the “unsubscribe” link in the footer of the email received or via contacting the Controller/Processor/Recipient via one of the abovementioned means);
- the right to request from the Controller/Processor/Recipient information regarding the processing of Personal data;
- the right to request from the Controller/Processor/Recipient the rectification of Personal data;
- the right to request from the Controller/Processor/Recipient the erasure of Personal data without any undue delay. The Controller/Recipient has the duty to erase the Personal data in cases accounted for by the GDPR;
- the right to request from the Controller/Processor/Recipient the information concerning the provision of Personal data to any third parties;
- the right to request from the Controller/Processor/Recipient access to your Personal data;
- the right to request from the Controller/Processor/Recipient the Personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable and interoperable format, and to transmit it to another controller in cases accounted for by the GDPR.
- in cases of any doubts concerning the compliance with the obligations of the Controller/Processor/Recipient regarding the processing of Personal data, the right to complain either with the Controller/Processor/Recipient or with the Office for personal data protection in Poland or responsible public authority of the Processor/Recipient’s jurisdiction
